EMR INFORMATION SHEET 2005

Dear EMR listener,

Thank you for your interest in EMR and for sending us a reception report to our world service. Listener response is an important factor for any radio station to survive, your E-mails - letters – phone calls and text messages are very important to us.

European Music Radio was first heard in February 1976 on 6250 khz with test transmissions and finally started a regular 3rd Sunday service in May 1977 on 6265 khz with hit music and information to Europe. EMR added a 41 metre service to improve reception in Europe quite successfully in September 1978, and in December 1979 we made a successful test to the USA with a good response.

Regular monthly transmissions successfully carried on until October 19th 1980 when EMR was raided and all equipment was lost, after this raid EMR continued with relays on 41 metres via the Free Radio Service Holland until the 12th June 1983 when EMR closed down.

EMR finally returned to the air for a period of six months with Roger Tate in the mid 1980's, You may recall his voice on the mailbox programme in the mid 1970's, he sadly passed away in 2001.

European Music Radio was not heard until February 1996 when a test transmission was made, and in 1997 a 4 hour 20th Birthday celebration programme was transmitted in English - French and Dutch. In January-February-March and April 1998 EMR transmitted a 24 hour Saturday night to Sunday night broadcast in English - French - German and Dutch to see what type of listener response would be for a monthly schedule, the response was fair.

EMR made more transmissions in 1998-99 and finally closed down in February 2000.

In 2001 EMR tried a new idea under the name of London archive, the programmes consisted of very old recording from the London landbased radio stations of the 1960's -70's and 80's, Listener response was very low and the service closed.

In February 2002 the station returned once again, and in November that year Legal transmissions via the Italian Radio Relay Service on 13840 khz were made, also in February and March 2003 we were heard with relays from Latvia and Laser Radio on 5935 khz.

More transmissions in 2003 were made via Latvia on 9290 khz and the IRRS on 5775 khz with many reception reports received (35 to 65 for each 2 hour broadcast) a very good Listener response to our programmes indeed with 75% of reports coming from emails 19% from letters and 6% from phone calls. On November the 30th 2003 EMR was heard with more transmissions via Latvia on 9290 khz, we continued in to 2004/5 with a great response to our programmes and with a solid signal all over Europe. We have been heard in many countries, places like Japan - India - China - Australia - New Zealand - Argentina - Brazil - Chile - Uruguay - Peru - Canada - The USA - Africa - Tunisia - Poland - Russia and many more from all around the World.

All Broadcasts are in English with music and International IDs to Europe and the world.
