On Sunday October 28th Radio Delmare tested during morning and afternoon on 6206 kHz. A few times a FRS-Holland test-cassette was broadcasted as well as Delmare jingles, a few commercials and a KBC cassette. For the VERY FIRST TIME since March 1984, when Delmare was raided, the station produced a STRONG signal covering wide areas over Europe. Problematical was the modulation but Johan Rood said already on the phone, one day earlier (Saturday 27th) that this was something which has to be improved. In that unexpected telephone-call FRS-Holland and Radio Delmare made an agreement with regard to a quick return on shortwave. In other words: If we were unsuccessful in finding a suitable power supply for the 500 W TX within a few weeks, immediately other measures would (will) be taken to ensure a very quick come-back!! We hadn't any idea about the (unexpected) good results the following day when the phone-call took place. The signal was coming from the 50 W TX. This CAN MEAN that we can even return already BEFORE the problems with the power supply are solved or BEFORE eventual other solutions will be found!! At least: on the condition that A) the mod. quality improves and B) the signal strength from last Sunday can be maintained. MAIN QUESTION has something been changed in the TX through which the signal has become much better? WE don't know the answer since we haven't had any contact with Johan after Sunday. Listen the coming Sundays on 6206 kHz!!
