Some info: we commence broadcasting at either 08.00 or 08.30 UTC. Close down will be at 13.00 UTC. You can find us on your dial between 6200-6300 kHz. Mark Stafford, Joop ter Zee, Stefan Kramer & Peter Verbruggen will bring the best in music, your dedications, the October mail will be handled, the jocks will play there favourite top 3 of 1995 and there is a great competition with fantastic prizes!!
